1. THUNDER - 30 MINUTES
2. LIGHTNING - 45 MINUTES
3. POOL WATER QUALITY EVENTS AS OUTLINED BY HEALTH DEPARTMENT GUIDELINES

You will be refused admittance if:

- You are suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
 - You have excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts or bandages.
 - You show evidence of a skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, a cold or ear discharge, an infectious condition or a communicable disease.
 - You do not have a valid Park Pass or evidence of daily admission.
- Hold on to your receipt.**

A special use permit is required for your day camp, day care, church group, school, civic organization, commercial use, or for groups of 25 or more. Call for info (914) 231-4556.

Westchester County POOLS & BEACHES SAFETY RULES and REGULATIONS

General Rules

- Children under age 12 must be accompanied and actively supervised by an adult.
- Visitors must obey lifeguards and all directions from staff.
- Observe pool depth markers and "No Diving" signs.
- Stay behind and clear of yellow safety lanes/lines at pools.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard-approved vests are allowed as swim aids.
- Proper bathing suit with lining is required to swim at all times. No shorts, cutoffs, etc. Lifeguard-style bathing suits are not permitted. A clean tee-shirt is permitted as a cover-up.*

* Exceptions for medical and culturally observant necessity will be made on a case-by-case basis.

For the safety and comfort of all visitors, the following are prohibited:

- Swimming while lifeguards are not on duty
- Diving
- Running, horseplay, rowdy or disruptive behavior
- Coolers larger than 12 inches
- Alcoholic beverages
- Glass containers
- Pets (service animals welcome)
- Loud radios, 70 decibel limit
- Tubes, floats, masks, fins and other aquatic accessories
- Toys and ball playing of any kind
- Diapers (except waterproof swim diapers)
- Smoking anywhere within the facility
- Cell phone use in locker or restrooms
- Underwater or action cameras
- Metal detectors
- Kite flying
- Drones
